**Report Definitions:** 12-Month Enrollment reports how many students were *uniquely* enrolled during the last fiscal year as of July 1. This is the official full year census date. Please note that **Traditional undergraduate** students take the majority of their classes by semester and courses meet two or three times a week for 16 weeks. **Accelerated undergraduate** students take the majority of their classes over an eight week time span and many courses meet once a week for about three hours. Many are nighttime courses and online or virtual. Please see the data below for the demographic contrast between these two student types.

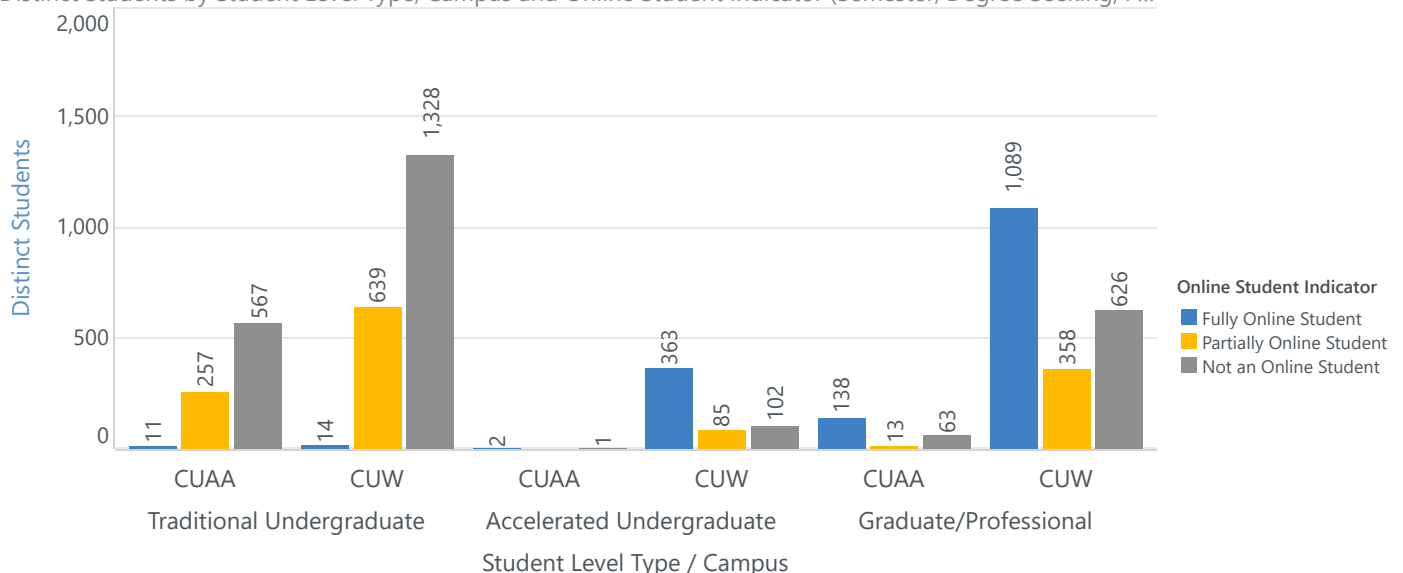

### Degree Seeking Student Course Delivery by Campus - Fall 2022 (Last Completed Fall Term)

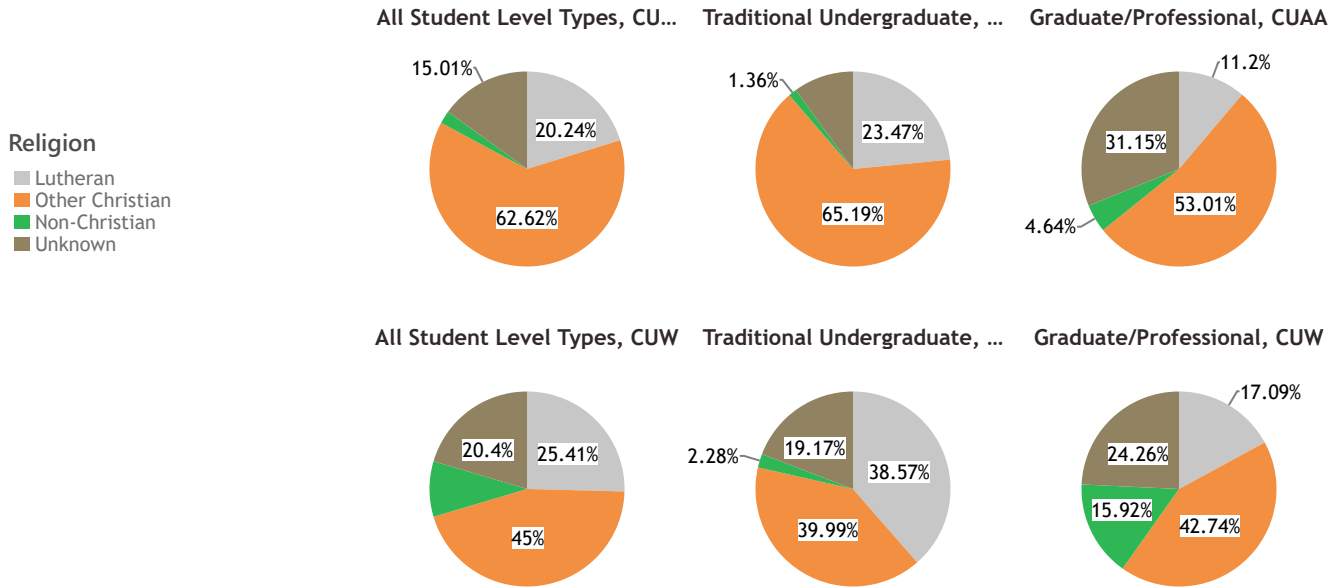

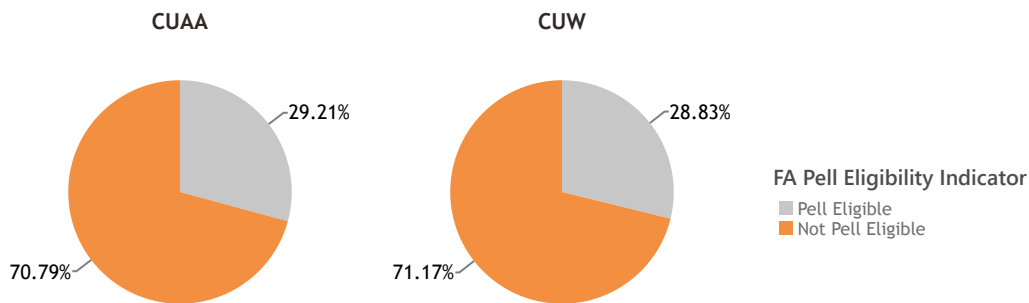

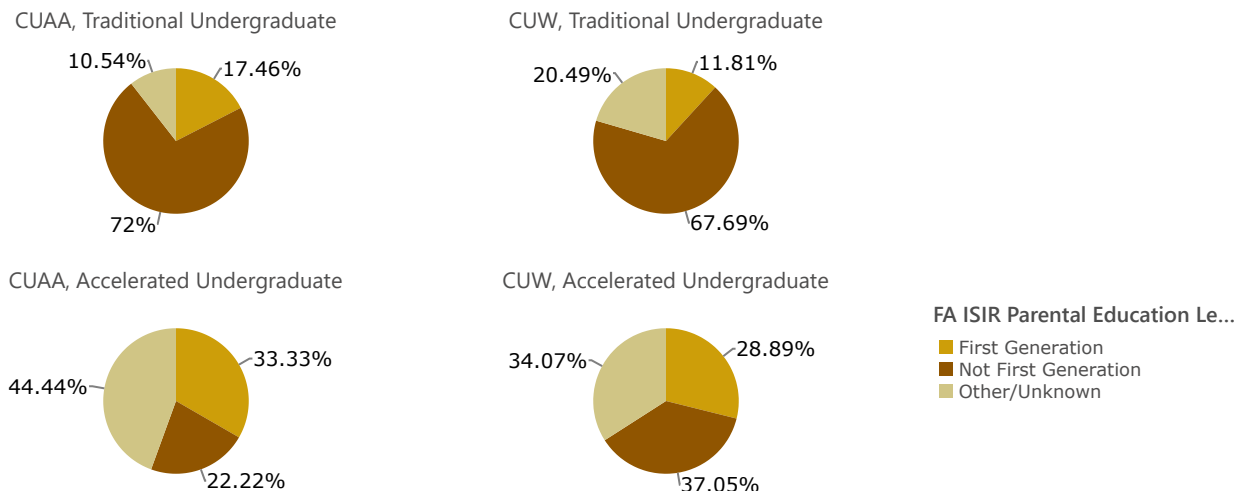
### Undergraduate Pell Eligible Percentages

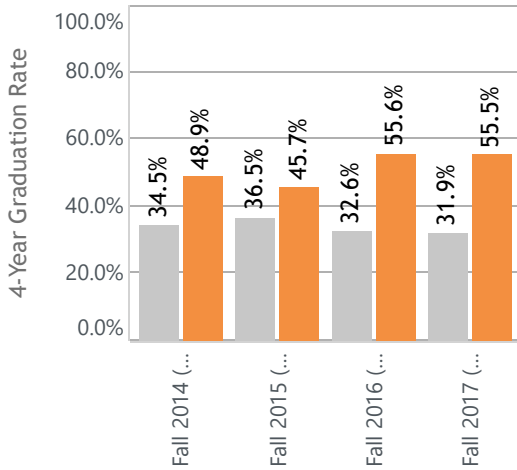

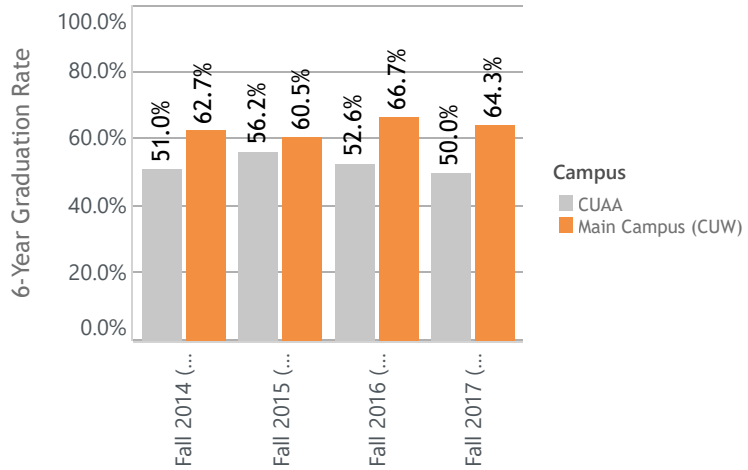
